EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM Appeal Process

Local Board 922600 - Rock County, WI

Rock County Local Recipient Organizations (LROs), may appeal the Local Emergency Food and Shelter (EFSP) Board funding decisions based upon the following criteria:

- 1. Within 30 days of board notification of EFSP non-award, the organization must appeal.
- 2. The appeal must be in writing and signed by the chief volunteer officer of the organization making the appeal.
- 3. There must be substantiated cause for the appeal. For example, if significant material information was not originally conveyed, there has been significant change within the organization, or if significant change has occurred within the community, an appeal can be made.
- 4. Within 10 working days of receipt of appeal, the Local Board will convene to review the appeal.
- 5. The Local Board's determination of the appeal will be communicated to the chief professional officer, as well as the chief volunteer officer of the organization making appeal, by telephone and/or email, immediately after a decision is made.
